



ProGlass Cleaning

Best practice guide

CLEANING THE FOOD DISPLAY:

1

Regularly clean the outside of the food display during each day using Cif Window & Multi Surface Cleaner and paper towel.

2

Clean the inside of the food display at the end of each day. Start by switching it off and removing all the food, covering and storing it appropriately.

3

If you can remove any shelves or trays, do so and clean them separately. To clean glass shelves, use Cif Window & Multi Surface Cleaner and a paper towel. Food trays should be cleaned and sanitised using Cif 2in1 Kitchen Cleaner Disinfectant and a clean cloth.

4

Spray Cif Window & Multi Surface Cleaner on all parts of the display, inside and out, ensure you cover all area

5

Starting from the top and working your way to the bottom, wipe away all dirt and grease using paper towel.

6

Finish off by using a dry paper towel to remove all streaks and marks, apply more cleaning product where needed.

7

Turn the food display back on and wait for it to reach the correct temperature before putting the food back inside.

CLEANING MIRRORS, WINDOWS, GLASS DOORS:

1

Regularly clean glass doors, windows and mirrors as required during the day to remove unsightly fingerprints and visible dirt. Don't forget the window frames!

2

Spray Cif Window & Multi Surface Cleaner directly onto the glass or onto a clean paper towel if there is a risk of harm to people nearby.

3

Starting from the top working your way to the bottom, wipe away all dirt, grease and fingerprints using a paper towel.

4

Finish off by buffing with a dry paper towel to remove all streaks and marks, apply more cleaning product if needed to achieve a perfect shiny result.
